A priest told the little kids they could come Trick-or-Treating at the rectory but they should dress up as one of the Saints.

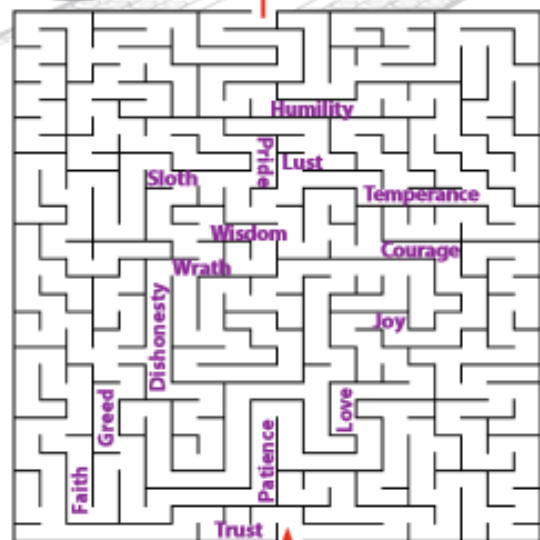
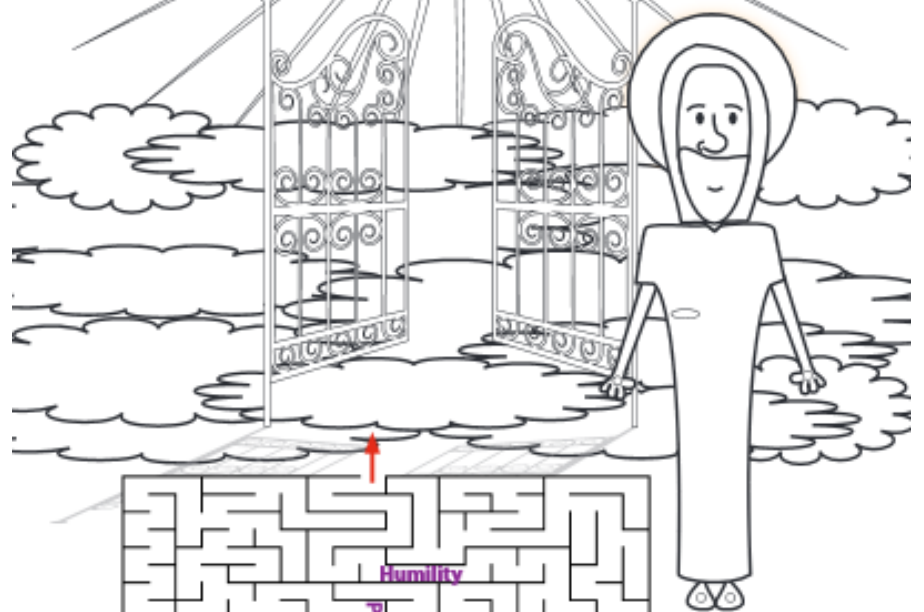
So the kids arrive and there's a little boy dressed up as St. Anthony, one as St. Joseph, a little girl as St. Clare and then there's this kid in a dog costume.
